Dr. Zuccala was one of the first area physicians to perform gynecologic robotic surgery. Additionally, he has lectured, taught and published articles on laparoscopic surgery, including pelvic reconstructive surgery for conditions such as vaginal prolapse, dropped bladder and urinary incontinence.
